True to their policy of designing eco-friendly buildings and furnishings, Foster + Partners have come up with a set of tables for contemporary settings. Made entirely of wood, the natural material par excellence, the Ava Table responds to the need to meet the demand for ecosustainability without forgoing the need to represent the space that every piece of furniture deserves. The table's bridge-like structure is a highly sculptural object with minimal detailing and a high-quality finish. The joints between the two sections are accentuated by a shadow gap that references architectural traditions. The geometry allows the end sections to cantilever up to one metre out on either side, while remaining stable and rigid.


