





Originally designed by Norm Architects for MENU's creative destination in Copenhagen's Nordhavn district, the Harbour Chair melds exceptional comfort with a strong silhouette. Striking the perfect balance between geometric and organic shapes, the contoured seat curves outwards at the back and sides for maximum support, enveloping the body in its slender shell. Furthermore, the low, ergonomic armrests ensure the chair slides neatly under standard dining tables.



The Harbour Collection

The Harbour Chair is offered in a range of materials and finishes, allowing for total customisation. The shell seat comes in a selection of colours, with or without upholstery, and the base comes in three solid oak versions and two powder-coated steel variants. The swivel version offers unparalleled freedom of movement and, if you so choose, casters for easy rolling. Sleek bar and counter height base options let you pull the chair up to your preferred surface, whatever its height.

Furthermore, the Harbour Side Chair can be paired with any of the existing bases from the collection. With its slender, compact shell, the design fits into more spaces and under more tables, providing additional personalisation in both retail and contract settings. The shell seat substitutes the need for armrests as its gentle curves retain the sense of being cradled and supported, while inviting complete freedom of movement. Beautiful alone or paired with the Harbour Chair, the Harbour Side Chair maintains the collection's elegant, minimalist feel.

The Harbour Lounge Chair is a sculptural piece with a minimalist expression; the solid yet lightweight construction retains all the hallmarks of its predecessors, while adding laid-back comfort to the collection.

Our Harbour chairs are set on a powdercoated steel or solid wood base, with the option of fabric or leather upholstery or a simple shell upper. The bare shell is offered in six different colours, while textile and leather versions come in a range of customisable colour options.


The base is available in seven variants for dining, as well as two for counter or bar and a low pitch on the lounger version, allowing you to mix and match colour, base and texture to fit your specific needs for the home, workplace or any other space you occupy.

Harbour Swivel Chair

Harbour Counter/Bar Chair



Harbour Lounge Chair


The Harbour Lounge Chair has the minimalist expression as its predecessors. Resting on a solid wood frame, offered in natural, dark stained or black oak and walnut, its embracing shell is available upholstered in a range of tactile yet durable fabrics in contemporary colourways.


The low-pitched frame features rounded legs and subtle joinery details, and the generous shell has a wide back, angled for comfort and supporting the body while providing space to relax. Ideal for relaxing into after a long day, it features the collection's characteristic curving armrests and a luxuriously oversized seat complete with a corresponding cushion.

Bridging the gap between an armchair and a lounger, it is set on a low-pitch solid wood frame with rounded legs and joinery details, offered in natural, stained or black oak and walnut.
