Archie armchair expands the collection designed by Yabu Pushelberg, reinterpreting the distinctive features of the chair version with balance and coherence. The slim tubular steel legs extend upwards to embrace the backrest in a single fluid gesture, while the joints between the different planes remain invisible, preserving the formal purity of the project. Seat and backrest welcome the body, offering immediate comfort, while the fabric or leather upholstery enhances its softness and helps define its sophisticated character. The result is an armchair with a measured, contemporary presence, designed to fit naturally into residential settings, from living areas to study spaces.

Seat and backrest

- The seat is made of plywood sourced from sustainably managed forests, fitted with elastic webbing and upholstered with PET fibre and a differentiated-density polyurethane insert.
- The backrest is made of co-moulded thermoplastic material and polyurethane.

Structure

Powder-coated steel tubular legs, 16 mm in diameter, conical at the top.

Cover

Fabric or leather, removable cover.
