The Basculer Lounge Chair pairs the relaxed aesthetic of a loosely fitted fabric cover with an innovative Vitra seat mechanism that offers automatic weight adjustment. Basculer is the French word for „seesaw“ and alludes to this mechanism: concealed within the chair, it responds seamlessly to shifts in weight and supports every movement with little resistance. The chair follows the body from an upright angle all the way to a deeply reclined, almost horizontal position.

For this extraordinary range of motion, Studio CE – Anne-Sophie Oberkrome and Lisa Ertel – designed a generously cut cover that drapes over the structure like a jacket. Tailoring techniques from the world of fashion - originally developed for ease of dressing and freedom of movement - have been translated into the chair’s

design. Fabric covers are available in a wide variety of colours, as well as in duo-tone versions combining two different hues for the inner and outer chair faces. The upholstering methods avoid adhesives. All elements of Basculer can be repaired or exchanged if needed, and the cover is easily removable for cleaning or replacement.

Basculer is available with a four-star aluminium swivel base or a wooden base, and comes in a highback version with an integrated height-adjustable neck cushion or as a lowback model – all variants are equipped with the same mechanism.

The Ottoman and Bench can be used as matching footrests, allowing users to put their feet up and enjoy Basculer’s exceptional comfort to the full.

Thanks to this range of variants and configuration options, the chair is extremely versatile and suited to multiple contexts – from living rooms to business lounges.

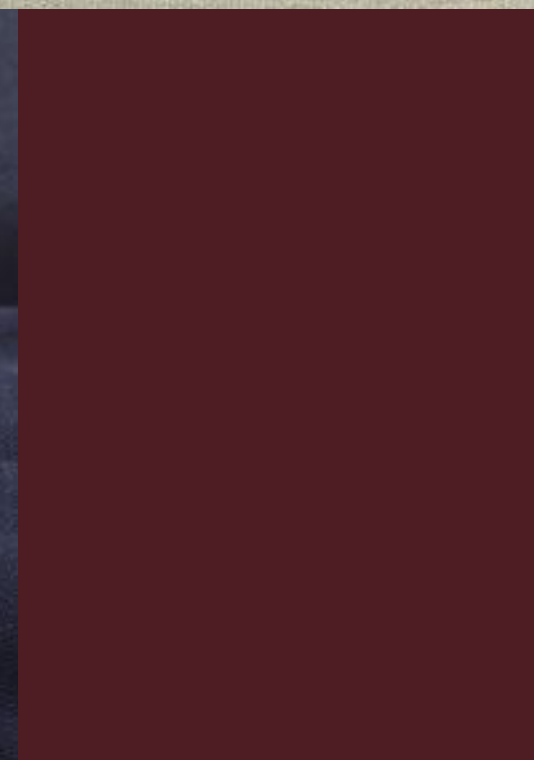

Materials

- **Structure:** tubular steel frame, powder-coated. Back covered with tensioned fabric.
- **Back cushion:** chamber cushion filled with PET fibres made of 100% post-industrial waste.
- **Seat cushion and neck cushion:** recyclable polyurethane foam „V-Foam“.
- **Armrests:** filled with PET fibres made of 100% post-industrial waste.
- Due to British fire safety regulations, V-Foam and recycled PET-fibre are not used in the UK. Fire retardants would have to be added to the formula, which would make it impossible to recycle V-Foam separately.
Exchange for V-foam: regular PU-foam.
Exchange for recycled PET fibre: fibre balls
- **Seat heights:** 380 mm (300 mm with applied load, measured in accordance with EN 1335-1:2000) or 430 mm (350 mm with applied load, measured in accordance with EN 1335-1:2000). Glides: hard glides for carpet; felt glides for hard floors available on request.
- **Metal base:** four-star swivel base in die-cast aluminium with powder-coated or blasted finish, choice of low or high seat height.
- **Wood base:** solid wood, oak with lacquered finish, low seat height.
- **Origin of wood:** oak (Quercus robur) from Croatia.
- **Mechanism:** steel frame, with automatic weight adjustment.

- **Note:** the neck cushion is height-adjustable (+ 6 cm). Total height with neck cushion in highest position 1125 mm.
- **Note:** Only one seat height is available for the wooden base and the Bench; seat height can be chosen only with the four-star base (lounge chair and Ottoman).
- **Note:** due to the soft nature of the upholstery and relaxed fit of the cover, folds and creases may appear in the fabric. Ripples and indentations from sitting (pressure marks) and partially visible outlines of the

chamber cushions are characteristic of high-quality, soft upholstery in combination with a removable cover and can be more or less pronounced, depending on the selected cover material. To retain the fullness and shape of your sofa, cushions should be regularly shaken and plumped.

- **For removable covers:** to avoid shrinkage or damage, covers should be professionally cleaned – do not put in the washing machine.

- **For duo-tone combinations:** the primary and secondary colours can be selected in the configurator. Important: a second colour can only be chosen in the same fabric. The Ottoman is not available in a duo-tone version – only the two lounge chairs and the Bench. Cover colour 1 (primary colour) is for the inner face of the backrest, the outer face of the neck cushion and the top of the Bench. Cover colour 2 (secondary colour) is for the outer face of the backrest, the inner face of the neck cushion and the underside of the Bench.

Basculer combines the relaxed aesthetic of a loosely fitted fabric cover with an innovative seat mechanism allowing a wide range of motion – from an upright angle to a nearly horizontal position. Drawing on tailoring techniques from the world of fashion – originally developed to

ensure ease of dressing and freedom of movement – Studio CE designed a cover that wraps around the structure like a jacket.

The cover is removable, and all elements of Basculer can be repaired or exchanged if needed. Basculer is available with two different bases, and comes in a highback version or as a lowback model. An Ottoman is also offered as an additional footrest.

Studio Œ

Designers Lisa Ertel (*Germany, 1990) and Anne-Sophie Oberkrome (*Germany, 1990) began collaborating while studying product design at the Karlsruhe University of Arts and Design. In 2021, they founded Studio Œ in Berlin. The Œ – a ligature formed from the initials of their surnames – symbolises the coming together of two perspectives within a shared creative philosophy.

Studio Œ develops projects grounded in material and context, understood as active components of the conceptual approach. Design is viewed as an open-ended process transforming insights and observations from everyday life into meaningful, precisely articulated solutions. The duo’s projects navigate the intersection of functional objects, spatial interventions and exploratory gestures.

They have been working with Vitra since 2025.

Bascule is the French word for “seesaw” and alludes to the automatic weight adjustment mechanism. Concealed within the chair, the mechanism responds seamlessly to shifts in weight and supports every movement with seemingly no resistance. The chair follows the body from an upright angle all the way to a deeply reclined, almost horizontal position. Without any fixed settings, the movement is completely continuous and, thanks to the automatic weight adjustment, no levers are required.

Sustainable materials

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Recycled aluminium



Alongside steel, aluminium is the metal most frequently used in Vitra's product portfolio. The production of recycled aluminium consumes only around 5% of the energy required for the extraction and processing of primary aluminium. All Vitra products that contain aluminium therefore include a substantial proportion of recycled material, which is being continually increased wherever technically feasible. The La Fonda base, for instance, contains 95% recycled aluminium. More than 90% of Vitra's aluminium components are sourced from suppliers in Europe.

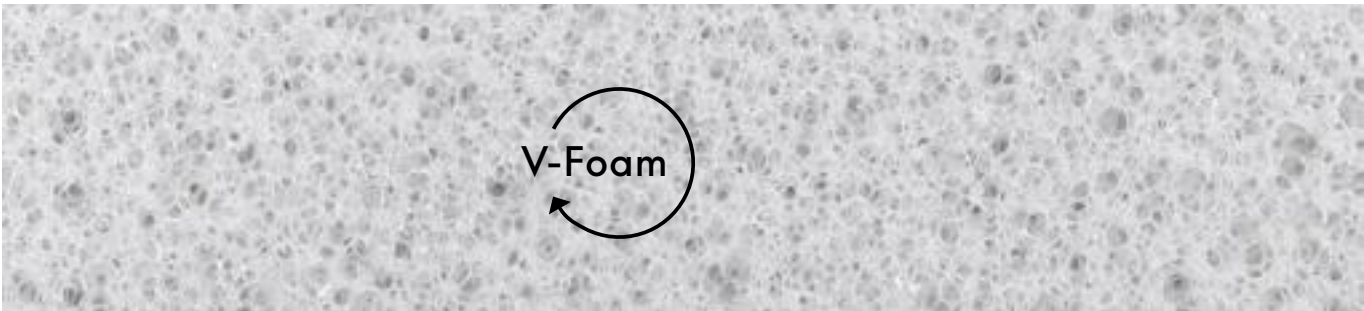
Recycled PET fibres



The armrests and the backrest cushion (chamber cushion) provide soft comfort with filling made from 100% recycled PET fibres from post-consumer and post-industrial waste that can be separated by material and recycled. PET fibres have excellent elastic properties and create a pleasant cushioning effect.

V-Foam - meltable PU foam

Developed jointly by Vitra and BASF, V-Foam is the world's first economically recyclable polyurethane foam.



Standard polyurethane foam (PU foam) is derived from fossil fuels and utilised extensively worldwide. Its recycling process is very energy-intensive and uneconomical.

V-Foam, on the other hand, can be melted, reprocessed and returned to the material cycle in its entirety for use in new products. Vitra will gradually incorporate V-Foam for all its upholstered furniture containing moulded foam from 2025.

The seat and neck cushion as well as the Ottoman seat upholstery are made of recyclable polyurethane V-Foam.

Hola – made from 100% recycled polyester



Hola is a textile made from 100% recycled polyester. Its finely textured threads are woven into a soft comfortable fabric with an understated expression and almost cotton-like feel. The robust, easy-care material is Oekotex-certified and exists in natural tones achieved through a dyeing process with a closed water cycle.

Cento: 100% new wool, 100% recyclable



Made of 100% high-quality virgin wool, Cento is fully recyclable and produced with a responsible use of resources. Developed jointly by Vitra and rohi, its material purity has earned the fabric the EU Ecolabel. Thanks to its excellent technical characteristics, the fabric is suitable for use in public areas with medium footfall, such as hotels and lobbies.



Vitra Test Centre

All Vitra office chairs are subjected to rigorous testing, based on the parameters of 15 years of use, at the company's own Test Centre. Vitra carries out tests that go far beyond standard requirements, with an

inspection catalogue comprised of the world's toughest tests (simulation of worst-case usage). Over the years, Vitra has developed additional tests of its own that are not found in any official catalogue of standards.

Colours and materials

Solid Wood

Wood is characterised by variations in grain, texture and colour, making each wooden furnishing a unique object. Vitra has strict quality standards for the woods selected for its products and uses wood from several trees for the manufacture of a single furniture object made of solid wood. As a result, every piece has a lively and distinctive appearance. The solid woods used by Vitra are mainly sourced in Europe and have an oiled or lacquered finish, depending on their application. Exposure to light will alter the colour of wood over time.

Metal

Vitra most frequently uses aluminium and steel for metal components. Since 94% less energy is required to produce recycled aluminium in comparison to primary aluminium, Vitra utilises aluminium consisting of 95% recycled material whenever possible. Depending on the product, metal surfaces are either powder-coated, chrome-plated, polished, galvanised, lacquered or blasted. A smooth or textured powder-coated finish provides colour and surface protection.

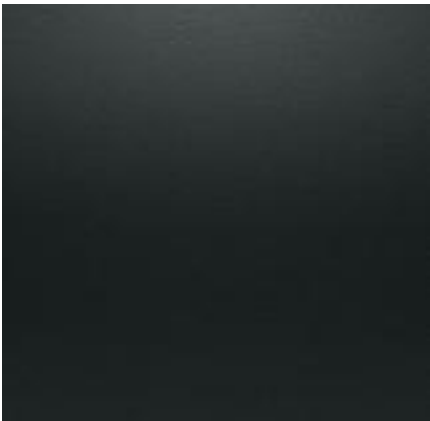
