NOMAD EASY CHAIR

DESCRIPTION

The deep cushion of the NOMAD easy chair is stitched to cocoon the body, folding over the armrests and moulding into the broad curve of the backrest. Designer Monica Armani used what she calls 'noble teak wood' for its warmth, smoothness and strength. Slender legs and contoured armrests give the chair its elegant profile and the smartly stitched cushion is as luxurious as it is comfortable. NOMAD, like its name, works well wherever it is placed, in combination or as a stand-alone piece.

MATERIALS

A-grade plantation teak from East-Java, every log is handpicked during the cutting process of the tree.

CUSHIONS

The filling of the cushion has a cover in a laminated, water-repellent polypropylene which prevents water from penetrating. The thread used to stitch the seams, swells when getting wet, preventing water from penetrating through the seams. The seams are also protected on the inside with an extra covering. If nevertheless water should penetrate, the material is breathable, letting moisture out to prevent moulding. Fabrics available in category D, E & F.

PROTECTION COVERS

For each item a cover is available that protects the furniture against dirt. These covers in grey colour are made of PU coated polyester which is water-repellent and UV-resistant. Thanks to their excellent breathable qualities the covers reduce condensation and heat build-up, helping to prevent the formation of mold and mildew. Nevertheless, they are not 100% waterproof. Always make sure that furniture, cushions and covers are completely dry before covering furniture.

MAINTENANCE

Treat new teak with Teak Protector 4 à 6 weeks after installation. Teak Protector applies an invisible film that prevents stains and green deposit. Soiled teak can be cleaned with Teak Super Cleaner. Leave the furniture to dry completely and then apply Teak Protector. To avoid labour-intensive cleaning, you can treat the wood with Teak Sealer. A simple cleaning with water and a ph-neutral soap will do for many years. Teak Sealer contains UV protection to slow down the graying from the sun as well as a fungicide to prevent the growth of mold and mildew.
